

3. Repairs Update





David Caron Maintenance Manager

The current national pandemic has had a considerable effect on the delivery of our repairs service. While we are committed to achieving our published timescales for repairs the requirement to shield, self-isolate and work from home has made this difficult for both ourselves and our contractors. We are grateful for your understanding and support during this difficult period. Should you have any difficulties or concerns about a repair please contact our customer services team on 0113 200 7700 who will advise and help.

When will my repair be completed?

Unity sets priority timescales for different categories of repair:

- Emergency Defects which pose a danger to health, safety and properties. Emergency repair jobs will be attended and made safe within 24 hours. We aim to attend 99% of these repairs within our priority timescale. Once the emergency has been made safe these defects may then require follow on work to be undertaken which will fall into our urgent, routine or non-routine repairs categories.
- Urgent Defects which seriously affect your comfort and convenience. Urgent repair jobs will be completed within 3 days. We aim to complete 99% of these repairs within our priority timescale
- ➤ Routine Defects which cause minor inconveniences. Routine repair jobs will be completed within 21 days, we aim to complete 99% of these repairs within our priority timescale
- Non-routine repairs Defects considered to be discretionary or minor repair works. We will
 agree a timescale with you as to when these will be completed.

Out of Hours Service

Our out of hours service operates after 5.00pm. It is important that all out of hours emergencies are phoned through to our out of hours contractors using the number detailed (0113 200 7700). If you try and contact out of hours using any other number, via the internet or via email this may not be picked up until the next working day. This could cause any emergency repair to be delayed.

4. Safety Inspections



Despite the current situation with Covid-19 it is important that we continue complete necessary safety inspections/tests to your home. This includes gas servicing, electrical safety tests and lift servicing. These works are required to ensure that your home remains safe. This work is a legal requirement and the government has been clear that we must continue to do them. We have developed ways of working with all our contractors to enable these tests to be undetaken safely and it is important that you allow us access to complete them where requested. We will work around you wherever possible. Should you have any concerns about safety tests contact our customer services team on 0113 2007700 they will advise you on what to expect during a test and how we can keep you safe when we do them.

Gas Safety

As a landlord we have a legal responsibility to ensure that all gas appliances, fittings and flues within Unity's homes are safe and properly looked after - this includes central heating boilers and gas fires. we carry out an annual gas service.




Gas Safety Tips

- Don't use any appliances that you think maybe, broken or faulty.
- Never cover a gas appliance such as a boiler.
- Make sure you know how to turn the gas supply off in the event of an emergency.
- Don't block or cover outside flues.
- Fit a carbon monoxide detector within your property.
- If you smell gas call the gas emergency number on 0800 111 999

Electric Safety Tips

- Check your sockets for burn marks regularly these will be checked on your safety test but if you have concerns let us know.
- Don't overload sockets or extension leads, try to keep to one plug per socket.
- Buy electrical appliances and chargers from a reputable source and check for a safety mark.

5. Income Advice





Income Manager Clive Greenwood Explains:

We know these are really difficult times, however we can still help. We wanted to share how we have helped many tenants already. So far since April we have helped 22 tenants receive £26,793 of discretionary payments towards their rent. We have helped a number of tenants work with **StepChange Debt Charity** to take control of debts including loans, water and electricity debt, council tax and rent arrears.

We have also helped tenants struggling to stay on top of issues at home by referring them to **Engage**, **Leeds Housing Options and The Social Justice Team at DWP**.

Lastly we know that our tenants are **savvy savers** and many of you will be planning ahead for **Christmas** so that you can afford the presents and food that you love to share. However it is really important, particularly with the possibility of more tough times ahead, that you don't rely on debt to pay for Christmas, because once you have debt, it is really hard to get rid of it.

Universal Credit tips:

You may be better off applying for, or staying on, other benefits instead of Universal Credit, so check first using our Benefit Calculator:

If you want help to claim Universal Credit call the Citizens Advice Bureau on 0800 144 8 444 for their National Help to Claim scheme.

If you cannot use the internet at all, you can also apply for Universal Credit by telephone on 0800 328 5644.

Help us to help you manage Universal Credit by talking to your IMO about how and when to pay your Housing Costs (rent) to us.

The Self Isolation Support scheme:

If NHS Track and Trace have told you to self-isolate, and you have a Test and Trace ID, you may be able to get £500 per individual for loss of income. You will need to be employed or self-employed and usually you need to be on a qualifying benefit. Contact your council to apply.

Universal Credit has a significant effect on us and our tenants.

Approximately a third of our arrears cases involve Universal Credit but make up approximately half of our arrears value (£166008).

Where tenants receive Housing Benefit or pay their rent to us directly approximately the same number of tenants are in credit as they are in arrears (over 450 of each).

However where tenants receive Universal Credit over three quarters are in arrears compared to one quarter (70 tenants) that are in credit.

We will work with you to ensure you have a credit on your rent account, or to reduce your arrears as quickly as is manageable. Talk to us so if you need to apply for Universal Credit, you don't end up with a rent debt caused by Universal Credit that you will have to repay.





10. Know a Good Neighbour?


